

## California Fire Safe Council Grants Clearinghouse 2012 results

You're invited to check the status of your grant proposal in the Grants Clearinghouse website: [www.grants.firesafecouncil.org](http://www.grants.firesafecouncil.org). The decisions that have been made are preliminary funding decisions at this time based on funding and the next steps in the Clearinghouse.

Your grant proposal was one of 196 grant proposals this year requesting a total of \$16.5 million. The preliminary decisions have targeted 39 projects totaling \$4.1 million for potential funding. Here is some important information to keep in mind as you check on your grant proposal. Please read it carefully as there have been some recent changes in the requirements:

### **If your project has been selected for preliminary funding:**

1. A grant manager will contact you in the next two weeks to introduce themselves and provide more information on the next steps with your projects. Please submit all required documentation to your grant manager via the U.S. Post Office mail. We are not accepting information via email. 2. If you have been selected to receive partial funding, please submit an application in the Clearinghouse. The application is automatically generated from your grant proposal and can be found on your online account. This step is necessary for you to revise your budget. **APPLICATION DEADLINE: Postmarked by NOVEMBER 4th, 2011 MIDNIGHT.**
3. If you have been selected to receive full funding, there is no need to submit an application for your project. You are, however, encouraged to review the automatically generated application in your account to check for completeness. Your grant manager will submit this for you once they receive your completed Pre-Award packet.
4. Please complete and submit the mandatory Pre-Award Report. The Pre-Award Report is a four page document that will help the California Fire Safe Council become more familiar with your organization and help us to create our sub-award agreement. Your grant manager will send you a copy of the report and it can be found here soon (please check back!). You will be prompted to submit supplemental information from the survey. All organizations are required to submit copies of this material, even if this information has been submitted in past years. **The Pre-Award Report must be postmarked by NOVEMBER 4th, 2011 and must be submitted directly to your grant manager via the U.S. Post Office mail**

5. 4. If your project involves fuel reduction activities, please submit maps of your project. Detailed instructions for the maps may be found on page three and four of the Pre-Award report. **DEADLINE: Postmarked by NOVEMBER 4th, 2011.**
6. You will be required to attend a Clearinghouse Pre-Award workshop in the next few months. Dates and locations for the workshops will be posted soon. Click <http://www.grants.firesafecouncil.org/PreAwardWorkshops.cfm> for updates.

--Partially funded projects: Some projects were picked for funding, but at lower funding levels. You'll see this when you check the status of your paper.

**If your project was not selected for preliminary funding:**

1. You may request feedback from the California Fire Safe Council. Please call the grant manager that covers your project area.
2. Your project will be held in the Clearinghouse until the next funding cycle should funds become available. Nothing more is required of you as we will contact you directly should this occur.
